All entry fee checks or money orders (US funds) are to be made payable to CAPER. One check is sufficient for all enclosed entries.

Entries for all events are to be mailed to:

Entries must be received by **6 pm CDT Wednesday, April 14** after which time no entries may be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted. No telephone or verbal entries will be accepted. All changes and cancellations must be received in writing (email is acceptable) prior to closing, except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows.

All entries must be on official AKC entry forms. Entries will be returned if they are illegible, incomplete, are submitted with incorrect fees, or are photocopied without the reverse side instructions and agreement included. Checks returned for insufficient fees will render the entry invalid; acceptance of such an entry will only be made if the full fees, plus a \$25 administrative fee, are paid via cash, certified check or money order & received prior to the start of judging. Express deliveries must include signature waiver permitting them to be left at the Secretary's address without receipt signature.

Entries received without signature release will be refused.

Refunds: Entry fees will not be refunded in the event of errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date; in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by the veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Show/Trial Committee; or in the event that extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Show/Trial Committee make it impossible to open or complete the show/trial. Refunds for bitches in season entered in obedience or rally will be partially refunded if requests are submitted to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of judging for the day & accompanied by a veterinarian certification.

Fax/Email entries: Entries may be faxed to the Show/Trial Secretary at 206-222-2830, or emailed to secretary@caper-dogs.com. **Both the front and back of each entry form must be included, completely filled out and signed, or the entry will not be accepted.** A copy of the entry fee check must also be faxed/emailed at the same time as the entries. Entry forms & fees must be mailed with a postmark no later than April 14, and received no later than April 17, or the entry will not be accepted. Entry fees must include a \$2.00 charge per entry form submitted. **Payment by credit card will not be accepted.**

Entry Acknowledgements: To ensure the receipt of your entries, it is suggested that you include a valid email address which you regularly check on your entry form, as that will allow the Secretary to send an email receipt of entry. If you do not have email, send a self-addressed, stamped postcard or envelope with your entry, which the Trial Secretary will return upon entry receipt. Judging programs and entry confirmations will be mailed to each exhibitor as soon as possible after the closing date. If the confirmation is to be sent to a person other than the dog's owner, please include with the entry the name and address or email address to which it is to be sent.

Exhibitors are responsible for the correctness of entries. Any errors will be corrected prior to closing; exhibitor errors discovered after closing cannot be corrected. Duplicate entries will not be refunded after closing. Overpayments of less than \$10 will not be refunded.

Moveups to Best of Breed or Open Jr Show classes: Dogs which, according to their owner's records, have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for this show may be transferred from the Dog or Bitch class to the Best of Breed class. Similarly, an entrant in a Novice Junior Showmanship can be transferred to Open if the junior has earned a third 1st place after this show's closing date. Each of these transfer requests must be made to the Show Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at this show.

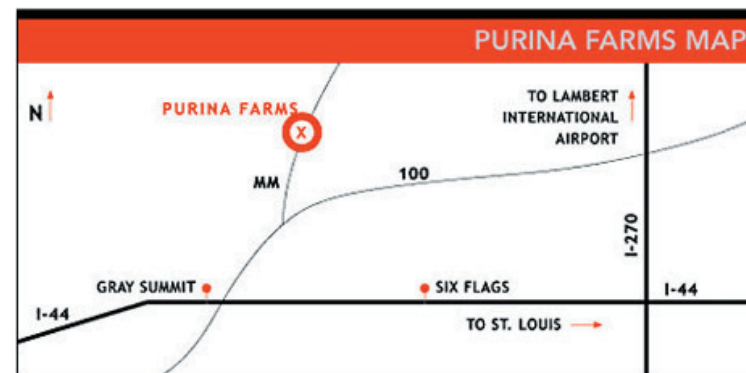

TEAM: Entry fees for Team classes are per entry, not per dog. Each dog's entry of a Team would have \$5 included for its Team entry fee (for a total of \$20).

Each Team is comprised of four dogs. Five dogs may be entered, one to be considered an alternate for which no entry fee is required. However, the same four dogs must perform all exercises. A separate entry form must be completed for each dog entered. "Dog" as used here means either sex.

Moveups will be allowed in Obedience & Rally per AKC regulations and must be submitted in writing to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of judging. Partial refunds for bitches in season will be given for each of Obedience & Rally, if requests are submitted to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of judging and are accompanied by a veterinarian certification.

Qualifying score required for all prizes in regular and optional titling classes.

SWEEPSTAKES**DISTRIBUTION OF SWEEPSTAKES PRIZE MONEY**

30% of total entry fees will be retained by Club for expenses.

The remaining 70% (for each Sweepstakes: Puppy, Veteran & Working) will be awarded as follows:

Best in Sweepstakes	10% of total Sweepstakes entry

Placements receive percentages of the entry fees of the class entered:

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP

Novice class: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have not won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Junior Showmanship class at a licensed/member show.

The Novice class is divided:

Novice Junior - 9 years and under 12 years on the day of the show;
Novice Intermediate - 12 years and under 15 years on the day of the show;
Novice Senior - 15 years and under 18 years on the day of the show.

Open class: For junior handlers aged 9-17 who, at the time entries close, have won three first place awards, with competition present, in a Novice Junior Showmanship class at a licensed/member show.

The Open class is divided:

Open Junior - 9 years and under 12 years on the day of the show;
Open Intermediate - 12 years and under 15 years on the day of the show;
Open Senior - 15 years and under 18 years on the day of the show.

PLEASE NOTE: Juniors must include their AKC Junior Handler number on the entry blank. Be sure all information for Junior Showmanship Classes is entered on the front and back of the entry form.

Offspring must be entered in a regular conformation class.

Entry is made for the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch - offspring are not entered on the entry form.

Brace Class

For two dogs, regardless of sex, performing in unison and presented by one handler.

Both dogs in each Brace must have at least one common owner.

Entrants need not be entered in any other class, but each must be on a separate entry form.

Champions of record and altered dogs may be entered.

Generations Class

For three dogs, regardless of sex, of three successive generations (grandparent, parent, offspring).

Entry is made for each dog (three separate entry forms) and there can be no substitutions of dogs.

Only one \$20 entry fee is required for the unit of three dogs.

At least one of the three dogs in the unit must be entered in a regular conformation class.

Individual dogs may be entered in only one Generations Class unit. Each dog has a separate handler.

Champions of record and altered dogs may be entered.

MOST VERSATILE MALINOIS AWARD

Dogs must participate and earn points (i.e. qualify) in at least four (4) of the following six (6) venues: agility, conformation, herding, obedience, rally, and/or tracking.

Dogs must be signed up to compete for the Versatility Award. Check the box on any entry form to sign up.

The Show/Trial Secretary will track results & points for each dog entered and will post standings daily.

The winner will be the dog earning the most points. In the event of a tie, each dog's scores of all qualifying performances from each venue will be added into its point total. The dog with the highest combined total score will be awarded Most Versatile Belgian Malinois 2010.

The winner will be announced at the Banquet and will receive a large black & gold rosette, Malinois coverlet, European-style trophy cup, & bouquet. Winner need not be present to win; if winner is not present, awards will be mailed.

Points must be earned in at least four (4) venues. The single highest point value earned in each venue will be used in tabulating the final standings.
